This project turned out to be the largest marine application of printed graphics ever! Ampco produced 992 panels to wrap the first of the three new C-Class BC Ferries. This ship was unveiled and launched in Flensburg, Germany in September and will arrive in BC later this year.



Sheriff's trucks are a common sight around Ampco as we do many of their vehicle graphics. What's different this time is that we used our engineering and product development expertise to create these interior control panels for the purpose of reducing chance of injury. And they look a lot better, too!
